Old Navy-866-580-9930-**Stuffed Animal and Creature Toys.** The stuffed toys have two button eyes that could detach from the toy, posing a choking hazard to young children. Consumers should take the recalled stuffed toy away from young children and return it to any Old Navy store for a full refund. Consumers who return the toy before July 1, 2009 will also receive a \$5 coupon toward a future Old Navy purchase.

Britax-800-683-2045-**Child Restraint Systems.** Models Frontier Red Rock, Frontier Rushmore, Frontier Pink Sky, Frontier Canyon, and Frontier Sahara. If the harness straps are loosened using one strap at a time, then the harness straps may become detached from the metal yoke located on the back of the child seat. Britax will mail the remedy kits to all registered owners free of charge. Owners who have not registered their seats with Britax must contact them and request a kit.

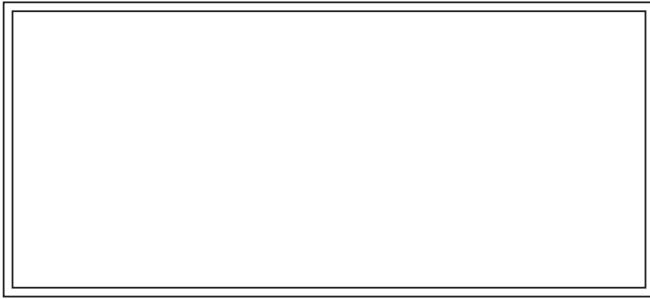

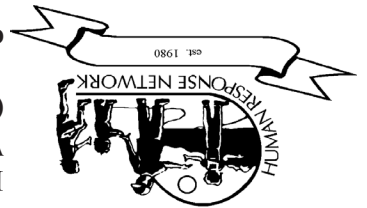
